Benefits of Using Math Challenges

- ~ Gives students an opportunity to apply math learning to new contexts
- ~ Allows students to experiment with the strategies that work best for them
- ~ Can be less overwhelming for students
- ~ Develops critical thinking skills

Math Challenge Examples to Try

~ Find the Number Pattern

Example:

Find the number pattern: 2, 6, 5, 9, 8

~ How Many Ways?

Example:

How many ways can you show an equation that equals 1,251?

- Basic Operations Find the Number Pattern & Number Crosswords / Searches
- ~ Order of Operations The Four Fours Challenge, What Order, & Secret Code
- ~ Algebra The Four Fours Challenge, Number Searches, & Secret Code
- ~ Fractions Find the Number / Fraction Pattern & Guess the Number / Fraction
- ~ Measurement Find the Number / Measurement Pattern & How Many Ways
- ~ <u>Data</u> Find the Number / Data Pattern & How Many Ways (Displaying Data)
- ~ Geometry Find the Number / Shape Pattern & Guess the Number / Shape
- ~ Money Number Crosswords & Number Searches (with money amounts)
- ~ General Problem Solving Math Riddles, Guess the Number, & Secret Code
